TITLE Topic: What did you do today? (Past tense of verb)

MATERIALS

- White board, markers, and erasers
- A bunch of pieces of scratch papers
- A projector, screen, computer, cell phone (in case if a projector does not work)

Students will improve their knowledge of the past tense of the verbs as they are drilling AIMS several verbs of the past tense, making sentences such as "I ate" and "I ran", and singing songs.

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Students will read sentences with "I" + present/past tense of verbs on the board, Listening

flashcards and lyrics from the song.

Students will listen to the teacher and classmates and past tense song throughout the Speaking

lesson.

Students will read aloud the sentences with "I" + present/past tense of verb, repeat the Reading

past tense song and present the past tense song they have created.

Writing Students will write several sentences that start with "I" + past tense verbs.

Discourse Conversation and discussion about actions (motions)

Functions Asking, answering, and singing.

ASSUMPTIONS

- Students know what noun, verbs, adverbs, and adjectives are
- Students can have a brief conversation in English
- Students make grammar mistakes often when writing and speaking
- Students can read short stories that are in easy level
- Students can read short stories that are in easy level.
- Students are familiar with "I"+ verb sentences. However, they are not familiar with "I" + past tense verb sentences.

ANTICIPATED GRAMMATICAL ERRORS AND SOLUTIONS

Students may have grammar mistakes in having the incorrect forms of past tense verb

- Error correction techniques

Facial expression: Give a sad/disappointed facial expression and encourage them by giving hints.

Ask questions: Keep asking questions until students get the correct answers.

Motions: Show motions that indicate the specific verbs/ Move teacher's position to indicate the difference between present and past.

Students may not focus on the lesson during the middle of the class.

- Error correction techniques

Clapping: Clap and say, "Ok guys!" aloud to get students' attentions.

Folding arms: Fold arms and remain silent until they notice that they should focus

Timing: Time how long they chat and let them stay in the classroom for the time they chat during the lesson.

1 min	Whole class	-Greeting	"Hello everyone!" How are you guys all doing?"		
5 mins	Whole class	- Recalling - Write down as many examples of present tense verbs on the white board - Say several sentences in "I" + present tense verb format - Ask + Answer	- "Last class, we've learned present tense of verbs and answer to the questions, "What do you do every day?" in "I" + present tense verb format. So, I want you guys to write as many present tense verbs as you know on the white board." - Invite the students to the white board		
3 mins	Whole class	- Teacher's explanations - Familiar with the past tense verbs	- Eliciting past tense verb by asking questions Questions are like "Do we still say I run even if this happened yesterday?" / "Yesterday? Last Week? Last Weekend? - Change the position to indicate the difference between present and past

MATERIALS

- Two past tense verb songs from YouTube

TIME	SET UP	STUDENTS	TEACHER
5 mins	Whole class	- Listen to the songs from You Tube and repeat the lyrics	- Play the songs and clap hands aloud
5 mins	Whole class	- Take notes	- Write the concept of past tense verb on the white board - Verb+d/ed or irregular forms such as ran/ ate/ took - Use the past tense verbs on the white board as references.
10 mins	Whole class	- Past tense verb drills - Know the forms of present tense verbs and past tense verbs clearly	- Indicate the present tense verbs written on the whiteboard and let students change them into past tense verbs - Move position from left to right and right to left (Left- present/ Right- past) - Mix up present tense verbs with past tense verbs with past tense verbs - Once they are familiar with the drills, let them lead the past tense verb drills by themselves

2 mins	Whole class	- Make 4 groups of 3 and organize the table	- Let students divide into 4 groups of 3
5 mins	4 Groups of 3	- Teacher's instructions - Create the songs using past tense verbs	- Give them instructions: Make songs using past tense verbs. There should be at least 10 lines
15 mins	4 Groups of 3	 Present the songs they have created Clap the hands to keep the beats Other students watching the team presenting the song say the line, "What did you do today" first. S1: What did you do today? S2: I studied/ cleaned/ looked S1: What did you do today? S2: I cooked/ ran/ ate Once they are done with the first round of the song, present the songs in both present and past tense verb formats S1: What do you do every day? S2: I study/ eat/ run S1: What did you do today? S2: I ran/ ate 	- Monitor them presenting the songs - Once they are done with presenting the song for the first time, say, "Okay, we are now going to present the song in both present and past tense verb formats." - Say, "What do you do every day or What did you do today?" randomly.

1 mins	Whole class	- Listen to the feedbacks	- Feedbacks with corrections
2 mins	Whole class	- Answer to the teacher's questions	- CCQ: "I run yesterday or I ran yesterday?"/ I eat every day or I ate every day?" - Purposely make mistakes in order to let kids correct the verbs
1 min	Whole class	Say, "Good bye" aloud	T. asks "Did you guys all have fun?" T. wrap up the class by saying "Ok everyone put your pencils and papers in your bags and don't forget to bring a worksheet by tomorrow!" T. says, "See you guys next time and have a wonderful day!"
