My SLA Experiences

I was born in Seoul, Korea. My family consists of 3, my parents and me. My parents are all Korean and they cannot speak any other languages except for Korean. Naturally, I was affected by my parents who could only speak Korean, so I could only speak Korean in my childhood. Korean is my mother tongue and somebody calls it language1 same as L1.

After I went to the elementary school, I began to study English at first time. At that time, I can remember that the classroom was entirely traditional compared to the modern classroom these days. Their levels of English were really various. I remember they were from the entirely elementary levels to really advanced levels. During the class, I have tried to give them more questions about CCQ rather than ICQ because there were no real activities in my classroom. I think they were following me very well at that time and it made me feel rewarded. This experience was absolutely successful and I can't forget it.

After graduation to university, I have studied Toeic Speaking Test to get a job. At that time, I went to English speaking academy to study. Every time I went there, I have to prepare Realia because there were many practical activities. The teacher was the type of the enabler. She was good facilitator of the class. First time of the class, we did Icebreaker to get to know each other, and it was interesting. The teacher gave us many useful feedbacks and I could get the score which I want to

get. It was successful.

I have learned English since I was in elementary school. It has been a long time. I have described my SLA experiences of English for my essay TESOL. Even though, I haven't been to English country for studying, I have tried to get the real SLA for a long time. Our country is typically EFL environment for the many English learners. I hope we can study English in the better environment like ESL which is casually used English in our common life.
