Aims:

Let students express their thoughts when they regret.

Teach students about the grammar you use when you regret.

Students will able to learn grammar naturally within a verisimilar situation.

Language Skills:

Worksheet 1 (Appendix 2) Worksheet 2 (Appendix 3)

Reading: Read the situation and understand when to use the regretting expression.

Write: Write down the right part of the sentences.

Language Systems:

Grammar : Should have p.p, Shouldn't have p.p, past participle. Lexis : Past participle (read→read, study→studied, buy→bought, etc)

Discourse: Share the things/acts that they regret, can easily say what they regret.

Function: Express the thought, Share the thought.

Assumptions:

Students have already studied about the basic verb words.

Students can understand the feeling of regret.

Anticipated Errors and Solutions:

Students can be confused about "should" and "shouldn't"

 \rightarrow Show the example situations so that students can understand the difference.

Students can have problems with past participle.

→ Let them know about the form of past participles.

Backup Plan:

Give students the word search puzzle worksheet and let them solve.

2 minute	T-S	- Greeting:" Hello everyone. My name is Jamie. Nice to meet you everybody. Today we are going to learn a grammar. Before we start, have you ever regret doing something?" Give students brief time to think about the question and get some interest about the topic.

5 minutes	T-S	-Teaching grammar : showing the rule of the grammar with ppt slides. Explain fully until all the students understand the grammar.
		- Showing examples : Show some examples that use the expression of regret. Make students easily understand the grammar rule and makes it easy to try and use the grammar.

6 minutes	T-S S (I)	- Worksheet : Give worksheets to students and let them solve. Give a bit of time to solve it.
		- Answer check : After students finish the worksheet, give the answer and check together with whole class.
		If there is a student who got wrong, explain about the right answer with everyone.
		("Do you have any questions about the worksheet?", "Does anybody missed among three questions?")


