Aims:

- Students will predict the meaning of 'How long~' and 'As long as' by watching and listening to Jon Boden's song, 'How Long Will I Love You'
- Students will know the form of the first conditional and how plus adjective by teacher's explanation.
- Students will practice the first conditional and how plus adjective by answering questions, making own sentences, and using in reality.
- Students will practice speaking and listening ability by sharing ideas in a class and present each other's opinion.

Language Skills:

- Reading: reading lyrics on the board
- Listening: listening to the music, teacher's instructions, explanation, and classmates' ideas
- Speaking: Drilling and sharing ideas.
- Writing: write a letter

Language Systems:

- Phonology: drilling
- Grammar: use of first conditional ("How long ~, As long as ~")
- Function: expression for the duration of period
- Discourse : Sharing ideas

Assumptions:

- Students have ever listened the song 'How long will I love you'
- Students have ever been falling in love someone.
- Students have already known the first conditional and how plus adjective.
- Students know the present modals

Anticipated Errors and Solutions:

- Students may have difficulty in understanding the meaning
 - → Teachers provides more examples.
- Students may have a hard time drilling.
 - → Teacher gives the students more chances to practice.
- If students need more time to finish their activity
 - → Be flexible with the time as giving student more time to finish their activity and cut off the time of post activity.
- If students finish their task earlier than anticipated
 - → Show the video and let them sing along again

10min Whole	Listen to teacher's lecture	How was the song? Do you like it? As you can see in the lyrics, this is all about 'You will love your lover forever'. This song use the phrases 'how long will I ~' and 'as long as ~' Why do you think these are good for showing your love to your mate? Yes, to use 'as long as ~' is you will always love him/her until the world ends. So it means you will love him/her forever.			

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		As I mentioned at the beginning, we'll study the phrase 'How long ~'. "How" is used to ask about the extent or degree of something. If it combined with 'long', we want to know the length of the time.
		Let's look at this part 'How long will I love you' Do anyone tell us what the mean is? Yes, you want to know the length of the time you love him/her.
	Think about 'How + adjective'	We can combine 'How' with another adjectives, do you know any? (write down students' answer)
		Okay let's practice with examples. ex) How many students in this class? How often do you come to TESOL class? How tall are you?
		And after line says 'As long as the stars are above you' It is the answer of the previous line. Stars are always above our head, aren't they? So it means this person will love him/her forever. The phrase 'As long as' means during the whole time that.
		Because 'as long as' is conditional phrase, you can't use it with future tense. You can see them in here. The structure will be like As long as + subject + present verb ~.
