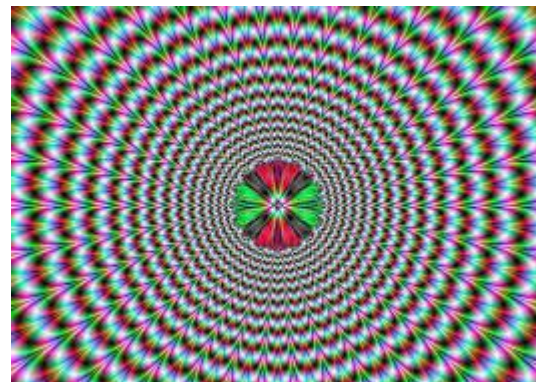
pulsate /'pʌl,seɪt/ Brit /,pʌl'seɪt/

1 : to make strong and regular beats, sounds, flashes, etc.

- The lights *pulsated* with the music.
- People danced to the *pulsating* sounds of hip-hop.

2 : to be filled with activity or a feeling

- Virtually every scene of the movie *pulsates* with suspense.





Bustle *verb* bus·tle \ 'bə-səl \

1: to move in an energetic or noisy manner.

bustled around the kitchen

2: to be busily astir : **TEEM**

The house was *bustling* with activity.

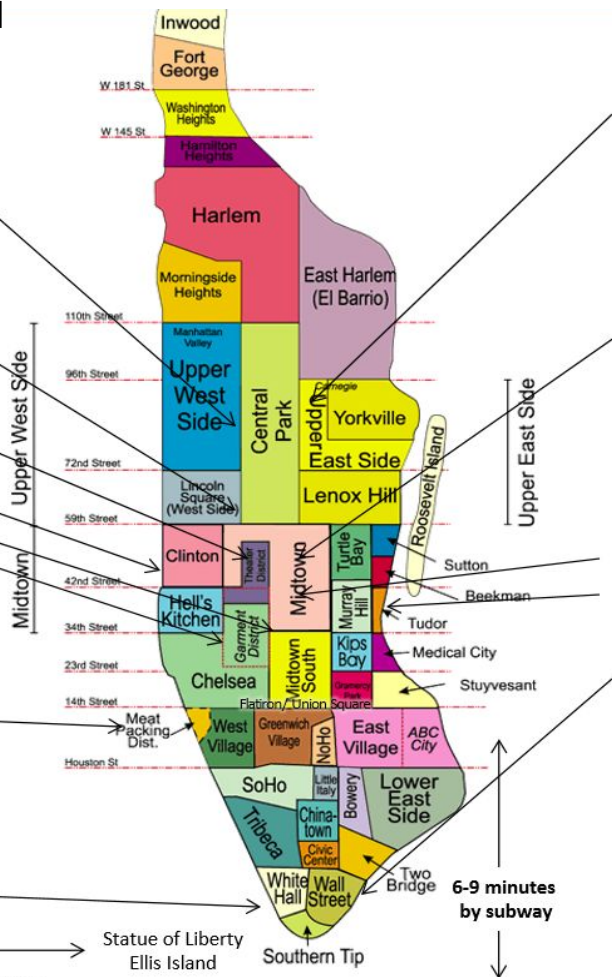

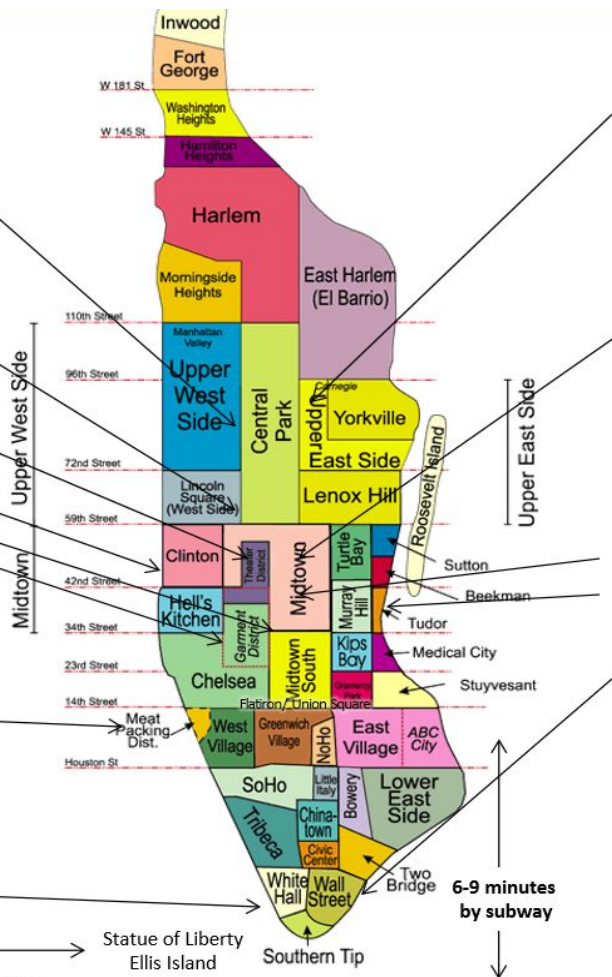

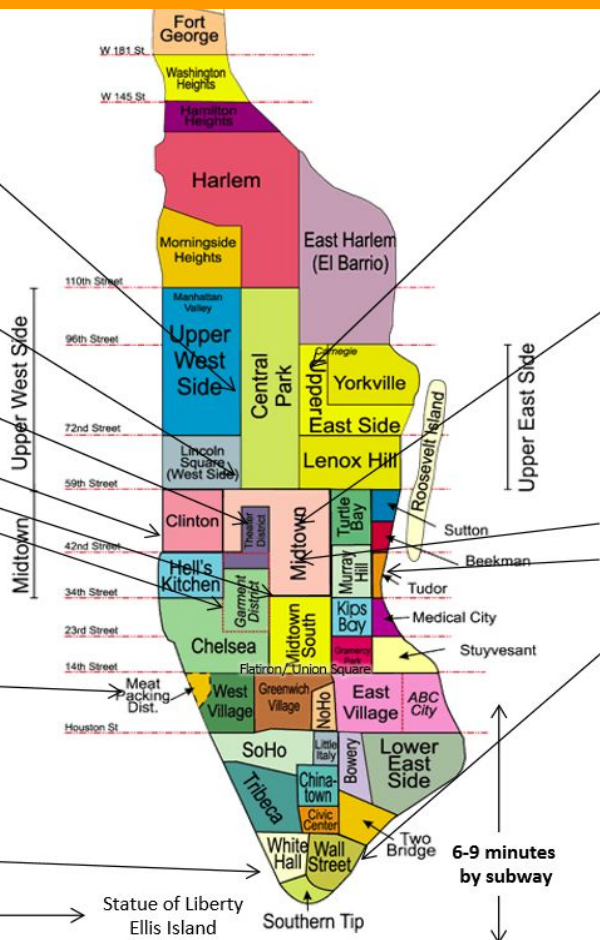
