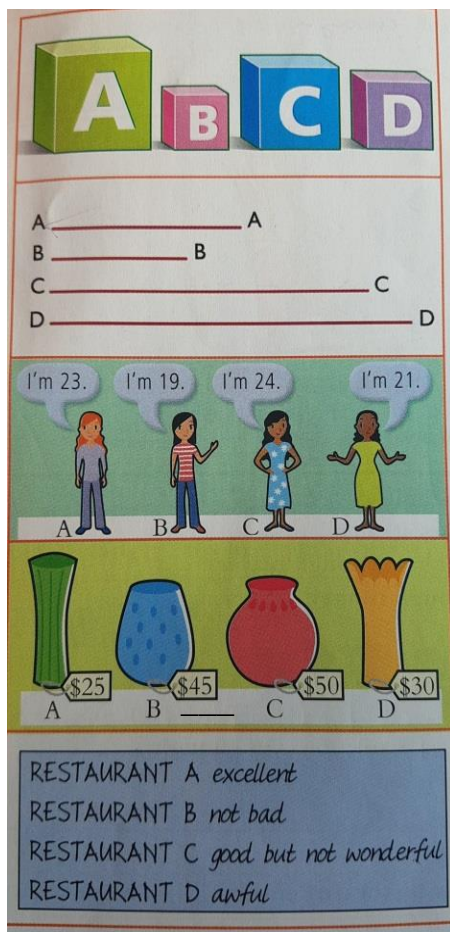

The + adjective(1 syllable) –est

1.

cold → the coldest

hard → the hardest

long → the longest

2.

t, g, n last consonant in 1 syllable word,
3 letters words → double tt, double gg
double nn

hot → the hottest

big → the biggest

thin → the thinnest

3.

y last consonant within 1 or 2 syllables

happy → the happiest

easy → the easiest

The most + adjective (2 or more syllables)

expensive → the most expensive

beautiful → the most beautiful

A few adjectives are irregular

good → best

bad → worst

far → furthest/farthest
